

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT FOR 2005

Incidents in 2005 showed a 1% increase on the previous year with a total of 395 calls. There was a marked increase in the number of hill-walking fatalities from 12 to 17. These included both deaths from medical conditions and accidents involving trauma. Teams also followed up an increasing number of requests for local emergencies. This can largely be explained by the calls for assistance during the January floods. The only areas where there were reductions in the figures were with regard to mountain bike accidents and people who were lost or overdue.

Previously I have commented on the growing number of calls coming from mobile 'phones. However in 2005 this number remained constant. Increasingly though these are now being directed to the Emergency Ambulance numbers and not to the Police. Therefore the tendency is to dispatch an ambulance and crew and only call the Mountain Rescue Team once the ambulance crew has arrived at the scene and found that they are unable to deal with the situation. Although by comparison, the number of calls to the Ambulance Service is maybe small, it should not lead to casualties being failed by the system. I feel that there is an issue here that needs to be addressed nationally with regard to Mountain Rescue and off-road incidents. Part of the problem would appear to be in the training of the staff at the Emergency Call Centres. Sometimes they seem to be unaware that there is a Mountain Rescue Service.

Another concern is the proposed merger of Cumbria and Lancashire Police Services, with the prospect of the larger constabulary having the greater influence. Cumbria, with the large number of mountain accidents and approximately sixty years of co-operation between the twelve voluntary rescue teams and the Police Service, has a unique working relationship developed by necessity, to affect speedy and appropriate responses. We need therefore to be pro-active in seeking involvement as early as possible, in consultations regarding the merger. We have raised these issues but so far there is no evidence in the present agenda to deal with these concerns. Perhaps as individual teams we need to inform those in authority of the valuable work carried out.

Of course the amalgamation of the Police Services is not the only such merger proposed. There are also plans in hand for the regional reorganization of the Ambulance Trusts. I hope that all teams responded to the consultation document regarding this. Although we have recently had worthwhile meetings with the Cumbria Fire Service, again we need to maintain the dialogue as their amalgamation plans are developed.

2007 will be the sixtieth anniversary of the founding of the first Mountain Rescue Teams in the Lake District. We have an enviable tradition of mountain rescue service that stands comparison with any other and we need to be vigilant to see that all these changes being brought about by Government, lead to improvements and not a deterioration in our service.

Mobile Phones & Mountain Rescue

Advice to Users

There is no doubt that using mobile phones have saved lives in the mountains and fells of this country. The sooner rescue teams are alerted to an incident, the better are the chances of a quick and complete recovery for the victim. However, over the past few years there have been occasions when teams have been alerted inappropriately. The notes that follow are given in the hope that the mobile phone can be used to better effect and to minimise any frustration.

When to use

- 1. if you or a member of your party sustains an injury warranting the assistance of a mountain rescue team.
- 2. if you come across someone who has sustained an injury warranting the assistance of a mountain rescue team.
- 3. if one of your party has become separated from the main party and you have made every effort to but have been unable to meet up again.
- 4. if you want to report having seen or heard any internationally recognised distress calls.
- 5. if you wish to notify someone of a change of plan (not a 999 call).

When not to use

- 1. Do not use the mobile phone at the 'first sign of troubleí; be self-reliant if possible.
- 2. Do not rely solely on the mobile phone as a safety device; there are areas of poor or not reception ('dead areasí).
- 3. The mobile phone is not a substitute for experience.

How to use

1. First make a note of all relevant details, Location (Grid Ref. if possible) Name, Sex and Age of Casualty.

Nature of Injuries or disability.

Number of people in party and intended destination.

THE NUMBER OF THE MOBILE PHONE IN USE.

- 2. Dial 999 and ask for the Police.
- 3. Make sure you tell the operator that you require the Cumbria Police as you are in the Lake District.
- 4. When connected to a Police control room, check that it is the Cumbria Police. If it is not, then make sure that the information will be passed on.
- 5. Explain the nature of your call, giving details previously prepared.
- 6. Do NOT change your position until contacted by Rescue Team, who will agree future protocol for use of Phone.
- 7. If you have to make a further 999 call, use ALL the above procedure again.

Advice To Those Using The Mountains & Fells

LIVE A LITTLE LONGER

British mountains can be killers if proper care is not taken. The following notes cover the minimum precautions if you want to avoid getting hurt or lost, and so inconveniencing or endangering others as well as yourselves.

Clothing

This should be colourful, warm, windproof and waterproof. Wear boots with moulded rubber soles, <u>not</u> shoes, trainers or wellingtons. Take a woollen cap, scarf, gloves and a spare jersey; it is always colder on the tops.

Food

In addition to the usual sandwiches, take chocolate, dried fruit, mintcake or similar sweet things, which restore energy quickly. If you don't need them yourself, someone else may. Becks on fells are drinkable if fast-running over stony beds.

Equipment

This must include map, compass, and at least one reliable watch in the party. A whistle, torch and spare batteries and bulbs are essential. Use six blasts or flashes repeated at one-minute intervals to signal an emergency. In winter conditions, an ice axe, crampons and survival bag are essential. Climbers are all urged to wear helmets, especially in winter conditions.

Company

If in groups, make sure party leaders are experienced; do not leave one or two behind to rest and catch up later. Take special care of the youngest and weakest especially in dangerous places. If you prefer to go alone, be very careful at all times. Let people know your route at the start, and stick to it as far as you can.

Emergencies

Don't press on if conditions are against you - turn back even if it upsets your plan. Learn First Aid, and keep injured or exhausted people warm until help reaches you. Get a message to the Police for help as soon as possible, and report changes of route or timetable to them if someone is expecting you. The Police will do the rest.

Dangers which Can Always Be Avoided

Ö until you know how to cope with them:

Precipices

Slopes of ice,

steep snow,

very steep grass (especially frozen), unstable boulders.

Gullies and stream beds,

streams / rivers in spate,

snow cornices on ridges or gully tops,

over-ambition,

carelessness.

Dangers which may Surprise You

Ö and should be guarded against:

Weather changes - mist, gale, rain or snow.

Get forecasts, and watch the sky in all quarters

Ice on paths

Carry an ice-axe and wear crampons - know how to use them

Excessive cold or heat.

Dress sensibly, and take spare clothing.

Incipient exhaustion.

Know the signs; rest and keep warm.

Accident or illness.

Don't panic. If you send for help, make sure that the rescuers know exactly where to come.

Flight of time.

Learn your own pace. Plan your walk.

Allow double time in winter conditions.

Pride.

It is no disgrace to turn back if you are not certain. A party must be governed by the capabilities of the weakest member.

Donating To Mountain Rescue

If you wish to support financially the Mountain Rescue Service, in the Lake District, the Association will be pleased to receive your donation. The Association equally shares out all it receives to the 13 Teams in the Lake District. There are several ways of assisting, some more financially advantageous than others.

1. Gift Aid

Following recent changes in the law relating to donating to charities, completion of a Deed of Covenant is no longer necessary. Most donations are now covered by a Gift Aid declaration. If you pay tax, Gift Aid is a scheme by which you can give a sum of money to a charity and the charity can reclaim from the Inland Revenue basic rate tax on your gift. You can make payments by cash, cheque, postal order, direct debit or standing order. Subject to a few rules, you can give any amount, large or small, regular or one-off and the charity can reclaim the tax.

If you want to make a donation through Gift Aid please complete the form printed overleaf having read the notes and return it, with either your donation or a completed copy of the Bankers Order to the Associationís treasurer.

- 1.1 If your declaration covers donations you may make in the future:
- Please notify the charity if you change your name or address while the declaration is in force
- You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity ñ it will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of the cancellation or such later date as you specify.
- 1.2 You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each pound you give).
- 1.3 If in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1.1)
- 1.4 If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
- 1.5 If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*

2. Give As You Earn
