

Chairman's Report

December 2015 will be remembered for the Cumbrian floods followed by the floods of Lancashire and Yorkshire on Boxing Day. Although our twelve teams supported by a further twelve teams from outside the county will have attended hundreds of separate flood taskings, 200+ in Carlisle alone during that second week in December, those tasks were only recorded as a very small number of incidents within this report. Putting the floods to one side for a moment, the numbers of mountain incidents attended by our teams last year is showing a very worrying and quite shocking picture. A total of 535 incidents across Cumbria compared to 474 in 2014, a 13% increase that we hope will not be an upward trend. Of great concern is the number of fatalities, 30 compared to 11 in 2014. The majority of these fatalities were medical collapses usually associated with a heart attack. The region's busiest previous year was in 2010 with 600 incidents and 30 fatalities.

The other activity of major concern is mountain biking. A 185% increase, up from 13 in 2014 to 37 last year. This figure is too high and somehow we must get a safety and awareness message to the growing numbers of people taking up this sport as injuries are not minor.

The tables at the end of this report, carefully prepared by our statistics officer are supported by additional notes to help make sense of any changes from previous years. Education and awareness of the dangers and risks for the ill prepared remains a prime concern for teams and hopefully in time the message will get across. I make no apology for repeating this mantra every year if it helps save a single life.

I said I would return to the December floods of 2015. During this period, over 500 team members from both within and from outside the county worked tirelessly, to help those in need of evacuation and rescue. Many worked 48 hours non-stop. Throughout December, from 4th December through until 27th December the teams incurred equipment damage and loss of over £20,000 uninsured costs and contributed 12,000 man-hours of volunteer time away from home and work. Notably, on Christmas day the region mustered 70 out of 150 mountain rescue swift water rescue technicians along with a further 53 support team members and thirty 4x4 vehicles, ready to leave their families and be deployed in the event of an expected second storm to hit Cumbria. As it was, the heavy rain skirted Cumbria to the south but hit Lancashire and particularly the city of York. We therefore asked for volunteers and deployed 46 of our specialist water rescue team members to support the effort of our colleagues in those flood affected areas, taking along with them a lot of the experience gained from previous major flood incidents, both from 2005, 2009 and the very recent flooding.

As a region we therefore remain very proud and privileged to be able to provide our voluntary rescue service. It is only possible through the generosity of those we rescue and the people visiting or living within our communities. There is very little in the way of central funding; therefore fundraising remains an ongoing and very important task for the teams with annual costs running at between £30,000

and £80,000 per team and rising. Donations, bequests and legacies, which are sent to the Association, do make a significant difference. It is gratifying to see that the work of the teams is recognised by both those we rescue and the general public who hear about the work we do. Income to the Association is shared equally amongst the twelve teams to supplement their own fundraising activities. It is important that those who donate know and understand that their contributions, however small, do make a big difference to the ability of teams to provide our free rescue service to the Cumbrian communities and to visitors in the area.

In conclusion, I would like to thank our many supporters, without your help and donations we could not exist as a volunteer service. I would also like to thank the external organisations and agencies with whom we work, the 430 volunteer team members of LDSAMRA and their families for their limitless commitment and support and the LDSAMRA officers, working groups and sub-committees for their dedication, support and hard work over the past twelve months.

Notes:

- 1. The increase in the number of reported incidents on the previous year is 13%. This was a higher than expected figure compared to the previous four years. However, it has not exceeded the highest annual total which was 600 in 2010.
- 2. An increase of 4% in the summer hill walking incidents is noteworthy; this figure appears to be consistent with the popularity of Cumbria as a holiday destination.
- 3. The doubling of the winter hill walking figure should not be a surprise given the wintry weather experienced at the start of 2015.
- 4. The dramatic increase in incidents relating to mountain biking is worrying. The growing popularity of this pastime has had a direct influence on the number of instances where help has been needed. This figure is too high; a strong message must go to all participants. Because of the speeds involved, significant injuries will result from poor judgement.
- 5. This figure is not a true reflection of the work involved this year in support of the statutory services and the community. Storms Desmond and Frank created significant work for teams both within and outside the county. It is also a measure of the growing reliance and trust these services have in the local mountain rescue volunteers.

Notes:

- 1. The increase in the number of people assisted is only 8%; there does not appears to be a simple explanation for it not being the same increase as the previous table, other than to suggest that small groups were involved than in earlier years.
- 2. The doubling of the number of people involved in winter-related hill walking should not be a surprise. It must be borne in mind that hill walking in winter conditions is very much more demanding, more dangerous and the consequences of a mistake are commensurately more damaging.
- 3. The number of people requiring assistance while rock scrambling has stayed fairly static for five years, unlike in 2010 when there were 74 people involved. This activity has many more dangers than hill walking and all the dangers of rock climbing but without the safety devices – a sobering thought if ever there was one!
- 4. This increase in mountain bikers needing help is consistent with the incident figure since these incidents usually only involve one rider.
- 5. It has never been practical to record the number of people assisted while providing assistance to the statutory services. During this year alone, the figure could well have been above 100. The figure that is shown represents the number of people who received direct assistance from team, possibly in the absence of statutory help.

Without mincing words, these figures make for shocking reading.

- 1. This figure can be further broken down into 18 deaths due to medical causes and 12 resulting from trauma, including drowning. 24 deaths resulted from mountain-related activities and 6 from non-mountain.
- 2. This figure is a big cause for concern; 11 of these 16 deaths resulted from a reported collapse, usually associated with a heart attack, but not exclusively. The remaining 5 deaths resulted from trauma following a significant fall and consequent injury. 11 were male and 3 female (the remaining 2 were not notified). The ages, where reported, were all over 50 years.
- 3. Three males in their 60s fell in wintry conditions.
- 4. As has been highlighted in previous reports, this activity can have lifechanging consequences. One death resulted from a possible fall, while the other from a medical collapse.
- 5. Unlike previous years, this death did not result from trauma but rather a medical collapse.

Most of the totals are consistent with the figures expected given the number of people involved in these activities, with the following exception

1. By its very nature, mountain biking involves speed. When accidents occur this results in the rider being hurled at speed into some substantial, and immovable object. If the rider is lucky, there are no objects in the way, but they end up re-grading the very rough surfaces on our hills and forests. The picture painted in many cartoons of bodies sliding 'for ever' across a rough surface is not too far removed from the truth. This number (27 persons requiring medical attention) is the highest on record. These injuries are usually serious and extensive for the reasons given above.

Causes of Incidents

The following table is the result of a search through all the reports for key words relating to the causes of calling out the MRTs. For example, the category 'Benighted' will include any word with 'benight-' and 'darkness' as part of the word or phrase.

Please note that the totals of these columns may not match the number of incidents given at the bottom of each column. Many incident reports refer to more than one of these causes. A typical report will illustrate this:-

'tripped on footpath whilst walking and fell 2m onto rocky ground' This will result in contributions to the 'Slip, Trip or Stumble' and 'Fall or Tumble' categories.

Notes:

- 1. It is sometimes difficult to distinguish between injuries to the lower leg and those of the ankle. However, if you combine these figures, they remain fairly constant year-on-year.
- 2. Injuries to the chest will also include situations where chest pains were reported or heart attacks diagnosed. This has been an oversight compared to previous years of these reports.
- 3. As a rescuer, head injuries are one of the more difficult situations to deal with, especially when lengthy evacuations are required. The head injury figures are routinely high because we will always err on the side of caution should head trauma be present or likely to be.

Lake District Search & Mountain Rescue Teams

For rescue assistance

- Go to the nearest telephone and dial 999.
- Ask for 'Mountain Rescue'.
- Give the location name & grid reference, time of accident, nature of injuries name, gender and age of casualty if known.
- Stay by telephone until police or rescue team make contact.

Mobile Phones & Mountain Rescue

Advice to Users

There is no doubt that using mobile phones have saved lives in the mountains and fells of this country. The sooner rescue teams are alerted to an incident, the better are the chances of a quick and complete recovery for the victim. However, over the past few years there have been occasions when teams have been alerted inappropriately. The notes that follow are given in the hope that the mobile phone can be used to better effect and to minimise any frustration.

When to use

- If you or a member of your party sustains an injury warranting the assistance of a mountain rescue team.
- If you come across someone who has sustained an injury warranting the assistance of a mountain rescue team.
- If one of the party has become separated from you and you have made every effort to but have been unable to meet up again.
- If you want to report having seen or heard any internationally recognised distress calls.
- If you wish to notify someone of a change of plan (not a 999 call).

When not to use

- Do not use the mobile phone at the 'first sign of trouble'; be self-reliant if possible.
- Do not rely solely on the mobile phone as a safety device; there are areas of poor or not reception ('dead areas').
- The mobile phone is not a substitute for experience.

How to use

1. First make a note of all relevant details, Location and Grid Reference Name, Gender and Age of Casualty.

Nature of Injuries or disability.

Number of people in party and intended destination.

THE NUMBER OF THE MOBILE PHONE IN USE.

- 2. Dial 999 and ask for the Police.
- 3. Make sure you tell the operator that you require the Cumbria Police as you are in the Cumbria.
- 4. When connected to a Police control room, check that it is the Cumbria Police. If it is not, then make sure that the information will be passed on.
- 5. Explain the nature of your call, giving details previously prepared (1).
- 6. Do NOT change your position until contacted by Rescue Team, who will agree future protocol for use of Phone.
- 7. If you have to make a further 999 call, use ALL the procedure again.

Advice to Mountain Users

Many calls to Mountain Rescue Teams are avoidable. With adequate preparation, awareness of local conditions, experience and the application of commonsense, the number of accidents can be reduced. The following points cover the minimum precautions you should take if you want to avoid getting hurt or lost or, in the event of an accident, minimise further harm to you and your party.

Planning and Preparation

- Plan before setting out! Maps are essential and guidebooks are full of advice.
- Consider the equipment, experience, capabilities and enthusiasm of the party members.
- Check the weather forecast and local conditions; Scottish mountains can be major undertakings. Night encroaches early in the winter and the further north you go! Check the website www.mwis.org.uk
- Carry a First Aid kit and learn how to give First Aid.
- Many accidents occur towards the latter part of the day when both your energy levels and those of your phone and GPS batteries will be run down. Did you remember to charge your battery before setting out?

Footwear and Clothing

- Wear suitable boots with a treaded sole and sufficient support for ankles.
- Clothing should be colourful, warm, windproof and waterproof.
- Take spare warm clothing and perhaps a hat and gloves; it is always colder on the tops.

Food and Drink

- In addition to the usual sandwiches, take chocolate, dates, or similar sweet things, this can restore energy quickly. You may not need them yourself, but someone else may.
- Streams on hills are drinkable if fast-running over stony beds.

Equipment and its Use

- A map, compass and the ability to use them; at least one reliable watch in the party should always be carried.
- If you carry a GPS, at least know how to read your current position. It could save a lot of hassle in an emergency when speaking to the Mountain Rescue Team.
- In all conditions, it is wise to carry a whistle, torch, spare batteries and bulbs; but in winter conditions, an ice-axe, crampons and survival bag are essential.
- Climbers and mountain bikers are all urged to wear suitable helmets at all times.

Party Size

- If in groups, make sure party leaders are experienced; do not let the party become separated.
- Take special care of the youngest and weakest in dangerous places.
- If you prefer to go alone, be aware of the additional risk. Let people know your route before you start, stick to it as far as you can and notify them of any changes.

Emergency Procedures

- Be prepared to turn back if conditions are against you; even if this upsets your plan. Report changes of route or timetable to someone who is expecting you.
- If you have a serious problem, get a message to the Police (999) for help as soon as possible and keep injured/exhausted people safe and warm until help reaches you. If you cannot contact anyone, use six whistle blasts or torch flashes, repeated at minute intervals, to signal an emergency.

Dangers - all can be avoided by good route-finding

- · Cliffs, slopes of ice or steep snow
- · Very steep grass slopes, especially if frozen or wet
- Unstable boulders, gullies, gorges and stream beds
- Rivers and streams in spate
- Snow cornices on ridges or gully tops
- · Exceeding your experience and abilities

Dangers – all can be avoided by remaining alert

- Weather changes these can be sudden and more extreme than forecast
- Ice on path carry an ice-axe and crampons and know how to use them
- · Loss of concentration, especially toward the end of a long day
- · Excessive cold or heat dress appropriately
- Separating from the rest of the group
- Incipient exhaustion know the signs; rest, take some food and keep warm
- Accident or illness don't panic if you send for help, make sure you stay put and the rescuers know exactly where to come
- Passage of Time especially true when under pressure allow extra time in winter conditions

Pride

 It is no disgrace to turn back if you are not certain. A party must be governed by the capabilities of the weakest member.

Donating To Mountain Rescue

If you wish to support financially the Mountain Rescue Service, in the Lake District, the Association will be pleased to receive your donation. The Association equally shares out all it receives to the 12 Teams in the Lake District. There are several ways of assisting, some more financially advantageous than others.

1. Gift Aid

Following recent changes in the law relating to donating to charities, completion of a Deed of Covenant is no longer necessary. Most donations are now covered by a Gift Aid declaration. If you pay tax, Gift Aid is a scheme by which you can give a sum of money to a charity and the charity can reclaim from the Inland Revenue basic rate tax on your gift. You can make payments by cash, cheque, postal order, direct debit or standing order. Subject to a few rules, you can give any amount, large or small, regular or one-off and the charity can reclaim the tax.

If you want to make a donation through Gift Aid please complete the form printed overleaf having read the notes and return it, with either your donation or a completed copy of the Bankers Order to the Association's treasurer.

- 1.1 If your declaration covers donations you may make in the future:
 - Please notify the charity if you change your name or address while the declaration is in force
 - You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying the charity it will then not
 apply to donations you make on or after the date of the cancellation or such later
 date as you specify.
- 1.2 You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each pound you give).
- 1.3 If in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1.1)
- 1.4 If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
- 1.5 If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity. Or you can ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*

2. Give As You Earn

This is a tax free way of giving to charities direct from your pay and many employers have agreed to co-operate. The donation is deducted from your pay before your tax deduction is calculated.
